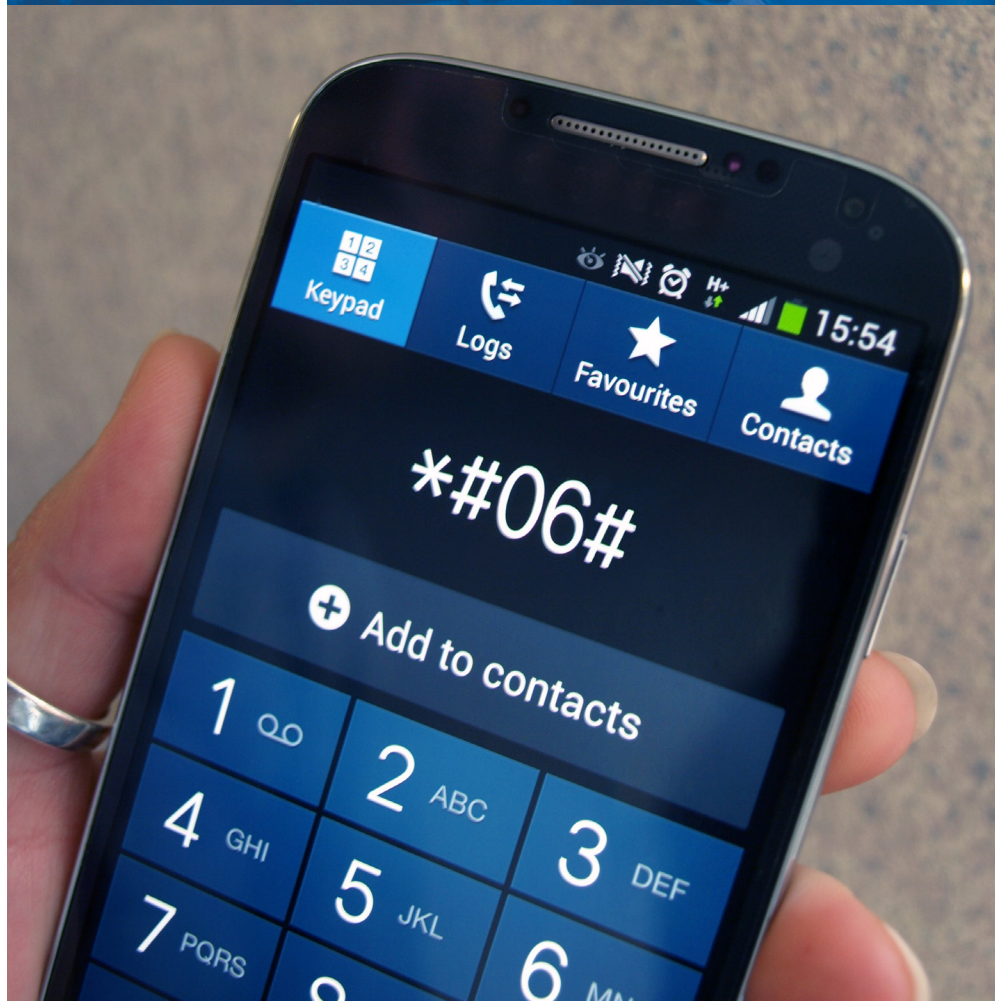


Protect your mobile



It takes **seconds** for a thief to strike.

It takes **seconds** to protect your property.

If your mobile gets stolen

Report your stolen phone to your network operator and the police as soon as you can – it can then be cancelled quickly, in the same way as a stolen credit card.

- note your phone's IMEI number by entering ***#06#** into your phone
- keep a record of your phone's details somewhere safe
- register valuable items with a property database such as **www.immobilise.com**
- security mark your phone with your door number and postcode
- consider using a tracker app to help locate your phone if it gets lost or stolen
- use your phone's security lock, if it has one
- stay alert when out and about
- avoid using your phone in crowded areas or where you might feel unsafe
- never leave your phone unattended – keep it somewhere safe
